


Beautiful New Windows

About that Roof

We had quite a leaky spring. The flat roof was over 20 years-old and the fact is, it was just worn out. The largest portion of the flat roof was replaced last month. Since the roofers completed the job, we've had a few big rain storms and we can safely say that the leaks have stopped. Unfortunately, there is some damage inside the building - mostly ceiling tiles and insulation that will have to be replaced. Also the Worman Room carpet took quite a soaking and will require some attention. Replacing a roof that large is quite expensive, but there is some good news. Money collected during the 2011 Capital Campaign was put aside in a JIF Fund specifically to cover roof repair and replacement. \$63,000 of the expense was covered using that fund. Final figures aren't in yet, and we may still owe an additional amount. Thank you to the wise Vestry members in 2011 who knew that rainy day would come and the roof would need replaced.
